
Research community taking the lead for Open Science Coordination

- Ministery of Education and Culture led open science strongly between 2014 - 2017
- Mandating research community led coordination in 2018
- Federation of Finnish Learned Societies taking the coordinator role

Formulating a declaration together



- 1. Draft written by the Steering Group (spring 2019)
- 2. Two commentary rounds
 - 1st: organizations on a management level (summer 2019)
 - 2nd: the entire research community (fall 2019)
- 3. Tuning the text based on the community's responses
- The Declaration for Open Science and Research 2020-2025 (Finland) accepted 10/12/2019 by the Steering Group

VISION FOR OPEN SCIENCE AND RESEARCH 2025

Challenges in the Finnish way of promoting Open Science and Research



- Collaborative writing vrs. someone has to hold the reins
 - Who makes the final decisions?
- Writing process
 - Making sure everyone is heard
 - Fitting different needs and wants together ->
 Compromises
 - Time consuming
- Implementation
 - Ministry led work has a special mandate



And the advantages are...



Democratization

- Everyone can take part, not only the usual suspects
- "By us, for us" → More binding, since its written by the community itself
- Quality and coverage
 - taking different point of views into account from the start
- Generating new forms of collaboration
 - Bringin together universities, university of applied sciences, funders, publishers, individual researchers...
