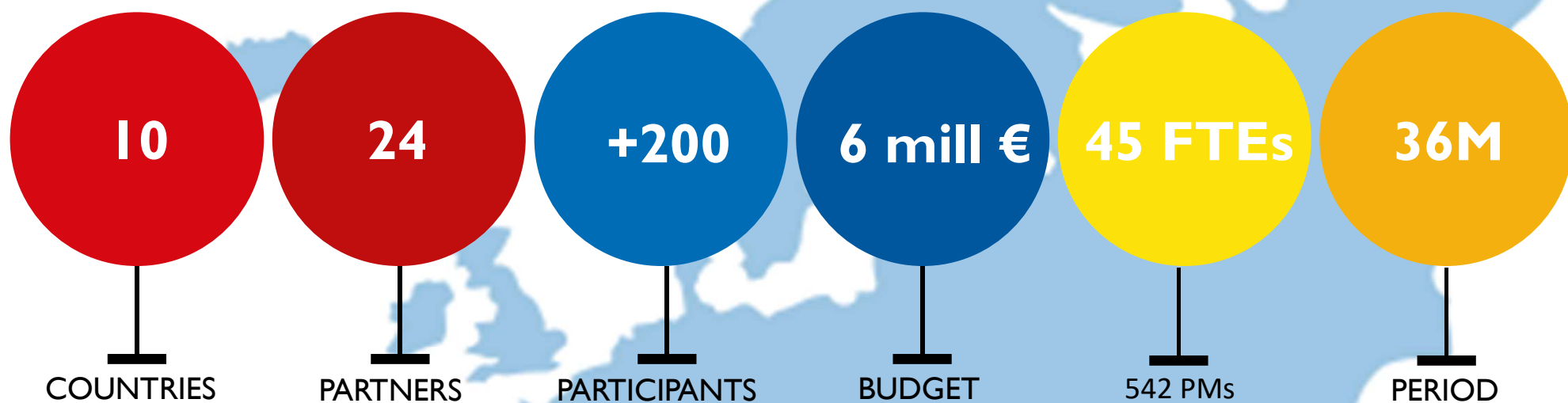

PROJECT IN NUMBERS



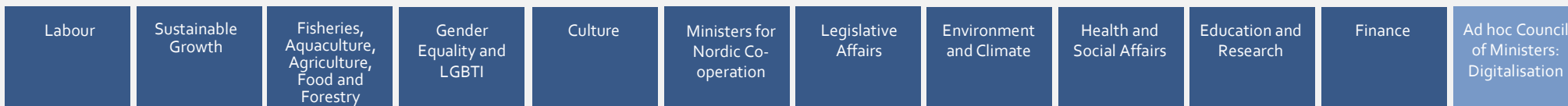

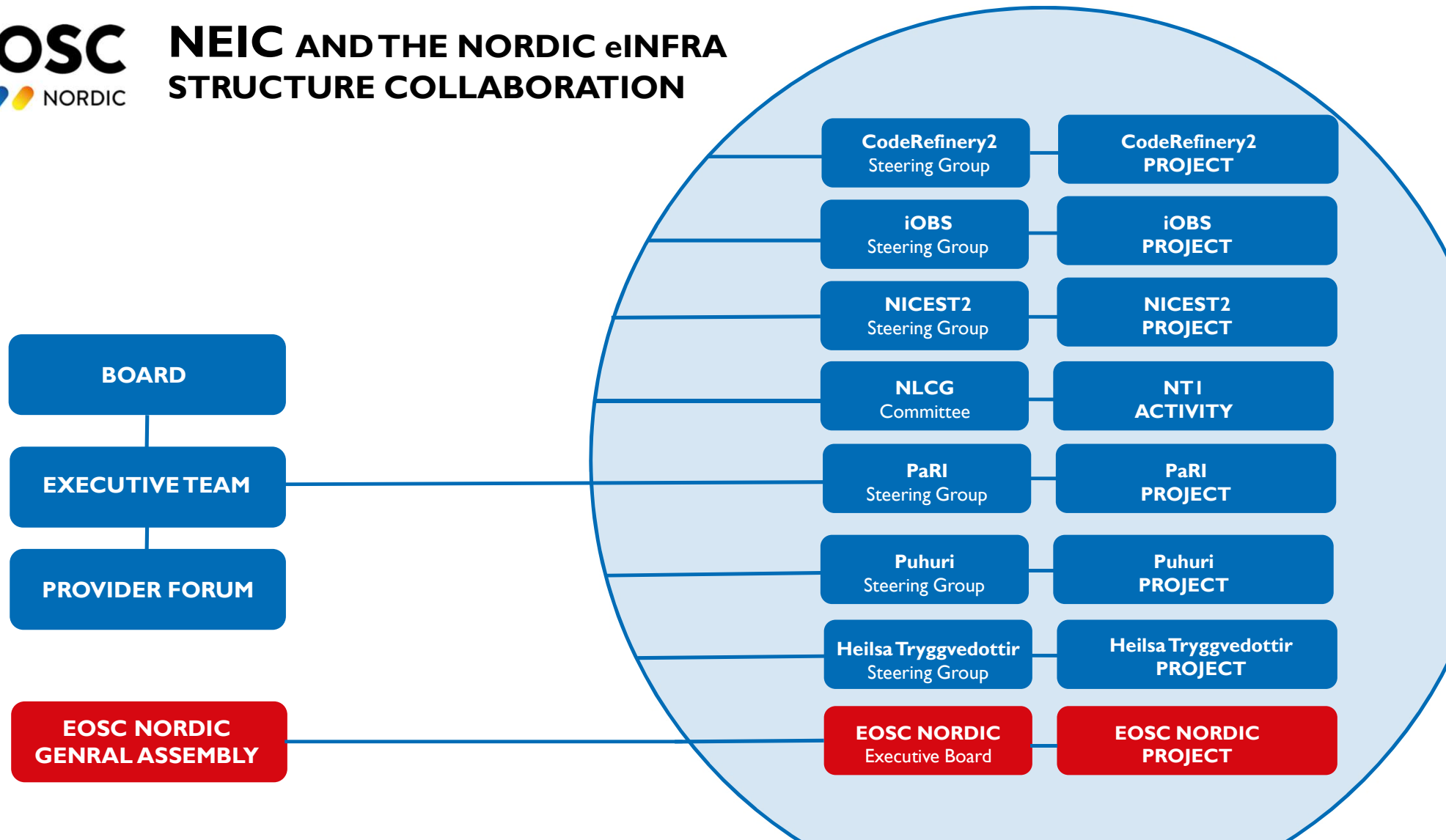

NEIC AND THE NORDIC eINFRA STRUCTURE COLLABORATION





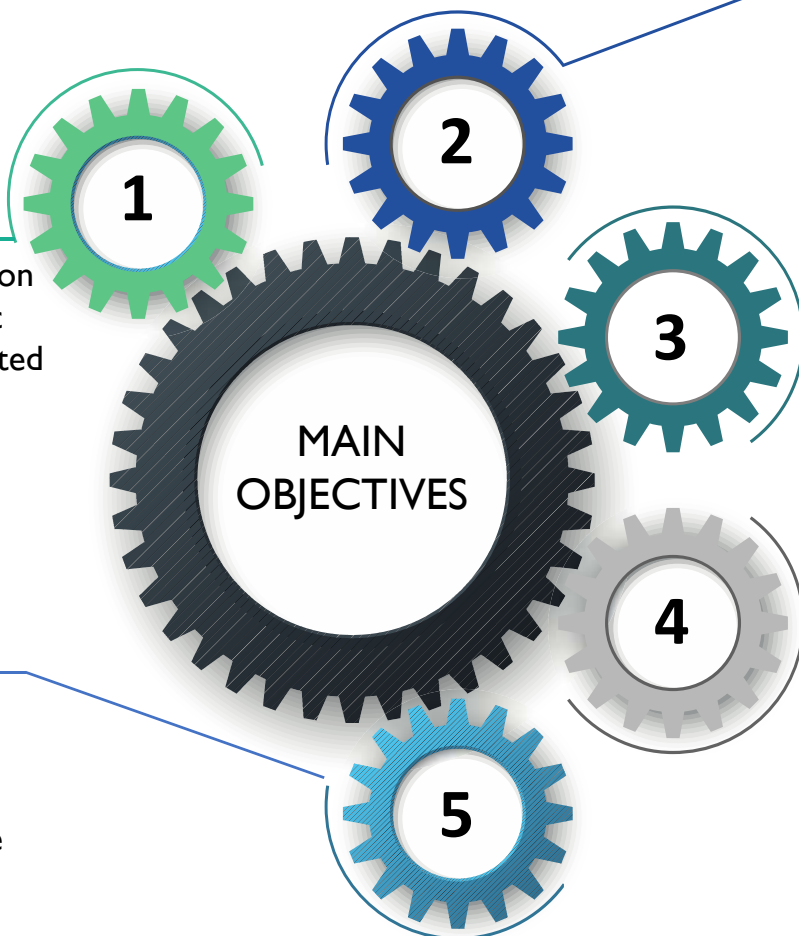
OBJECTIVE 1

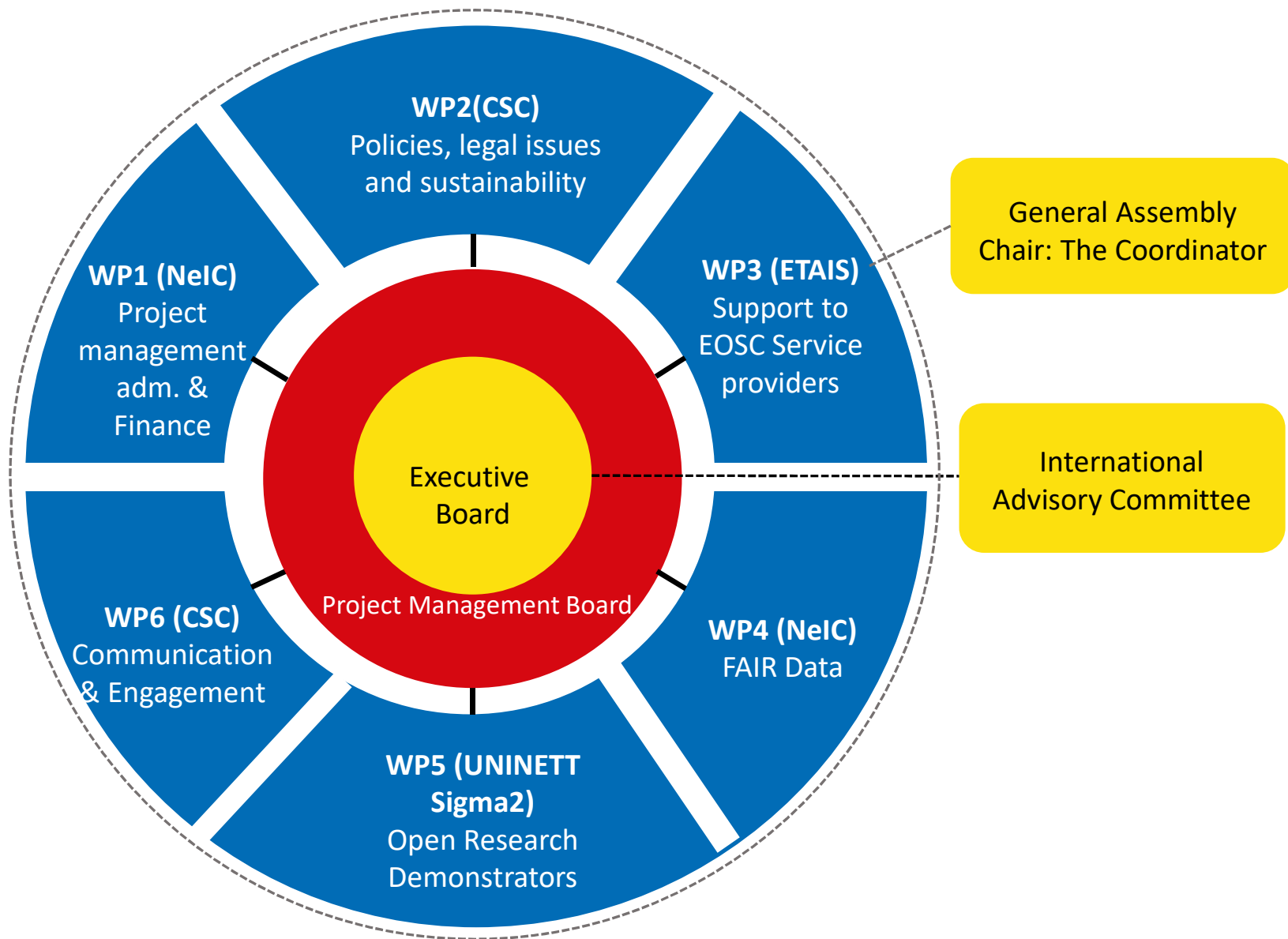

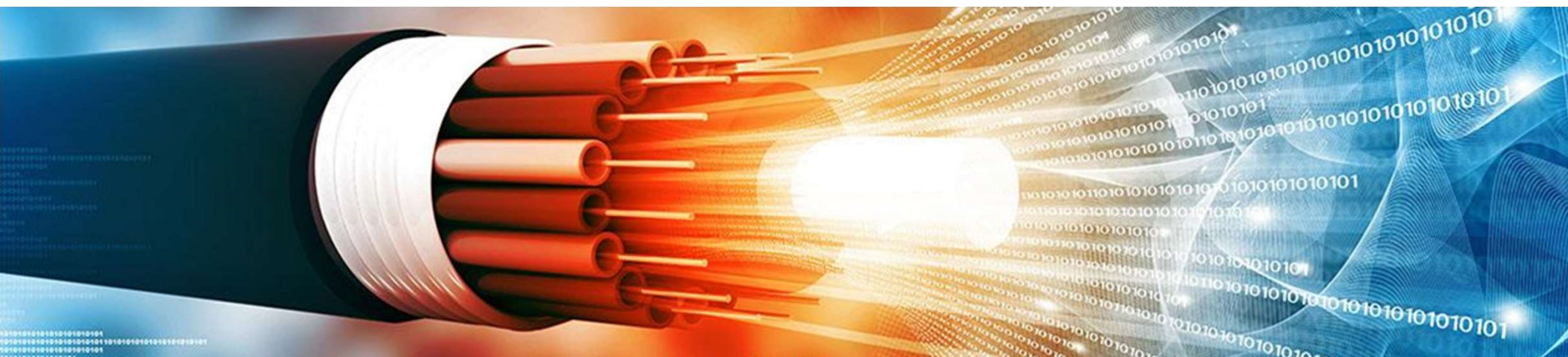
